CatalogIt Public API Reference

Overview

The following are the current public CatalogIt API endpoints. These endpoints are available at https://api.catalogit.app/api/public.

Currently no authorization is required to call these endpoints. However, in the near future authorization will be required. Details of authorization have not yet been determined but will most likely be an OAuth2 time expiring access—token/refresh—token. When authentication is enforced it will be controlled via the HTTP Authorization header. For example:

```
curl -H "Authorization: Bearer <access-token>"

Responses

HTTP Status Codes

Valid responses return an HTTP status code in the 200 range. Error responses return an HTTP status code in the 400 and 500 range.

Encoding

All responses are JSON and UTF-8 encoded: Content-Type: application/json; charset=utf-8

Pagination

List results are paginated using a page size and cursor request/response signuature. Pagination arguments are optional; if ommitted the first 5000 results will be returned (i.e. pagination defaults to size=5000). The total property in the response represents the total number of items available; the size represents how many were returned in the current call.

Size: You can control the size of the pagination window (the number of items returned in a single request/response) with the Size query parameter. The default is 5000 if not specified.

Cursor: Endpoints return a maximum of Size (see above, default 5000) hits per request and use a "cursor" token to support paging through result-sets that have more than "size" items. If the response does not contain all the items and there are more to request then the response will have a "cursor" property whose value must be passed as the "cursor" query parameter in a subsequent request to the same URL. "cursor" appearing in a response signals that there are more items that need to be requested; the value of the "cursor" property must be used in a request to get more items. If the number of hits exactly matches the "size" query argument a harmless, phantom "cursor" value will be included in the response which will return 0 additional entries when used in a subsequent request.

Errors

Details of error responses are available in a JSON encoded response body:

Versioning

The API is currently unversioned. This isn't good -- we know. We're thinking of changing the URL path to include a version identifier along the lines of:

```
https://api.catalogit.app/v1/public/...
```

Having api in the path is redundant given that the domain is api.catalogit.app.

Get Featured Items

Account

Get list of all Accounts

```

Get single Account

```
# get specified account
GET /accounts/:id returns info for a single account
# curl example
curl "https://api.catalogit.app/api/public/accounts/110"
```

Classifications

Get list of all classsifications

Note: the /classifications endpoint is a "list" response but is not paginated because the total number of classifications is limited and will never be that large.

```
# list distinct classifications
GET /classifications

# curl example
curl "https://api.catalogit.app/api/public/classifications"

Get list of all Entries in Classification

```
# get Entries of specified classification
GET /classifications/:id/entries?size:number&cursor=:string

Account relationships - folders, entries, profiles, media

Get list of all Entries in account

```

GET /accounts/:account-id/entries?size:number&cursor=:string

Folders

Get list of all Folders in account

Note: the /accounts/:account-id/folders endpoint is a "list" response but is not paginated. The total number of folders in an account should never be so large that pagination is required; the system will place a hard limit on the number of permitted folders.

```
# get list of shared folders in account
GET /accounts/:account-id/folders

# curl example
curl "https://api.catalogit.app/api/public/accounts/110/folders"
```

Get information for a single Folder

```
# get Folder info
GET /accounts/:account-id/folders/:folder-id

curl "https://api.catalogit.app/api/public/accounts/110/folders/2d907da0-

Get list of all Entries in Folder (in Account)

```
# get all entries in folder in account
GET /accounts/:account-id/folders/:folder/entries?
size=:number&cursor=:string

Get all Media in account

Not implemented - not convinced it has any value

```
GET /accounts/:account-id/media/ get all media in account
```

Entries

Get detailed information for a single Entry

```
# get detail on single entry
GET /accounts/:account-id/entries/:id

# curl example
curl "https://api.catalogit.app/api/public/accounts/110/entries/c835daf0-
20cc-11e8-bbaa-2198fc1bc3a4"
```

Profiles

Get the list of published Profile types in account

```
# get all Profile types that are published in account
GET /accounts/:account-id/profiles

# curl example
curl "https://api.catalogit.app/api/public/accounts/110/profiles"
```

Get all Profiles for a type (i.e. Person, Place, etc.)

```
# get all Profiles in the account for the specified type
GET /accounts/:account-id/profiles/:typeURI?size=:number&cursor=:string

Important: types (Person, Place, Color, etc.) are uniquely represented using a URI. You can use the GET /accounts/:account-id/profiles endpoint to get the URI for a specific Profile type. You must URI encode the type URI when including it as part of an API request URL. The example below shows the encoded URI for the Person type:

GET detailed information for a single Profile

Note: Each Profile has a unique identifier which is a URI. You must URI encode this id when including it as part of an API request URL. The example below shows the encoded URI for the id:

http://www.catalogit.me/rdf/individuals/b91f2420-57ac-11ec-b241-0d9c36065167

GET /accounts/:account-id/profile/:id

**Important:** Profile ids are uniquely represented using a URI. You must
URI encode the type URI when including it as part of an API request URL.

Searching

Search globally accross all Accounts, Folders, Entries, and Profiles

Searches everything for any matching Account, Folder, Entry, or Profile. This endpoint's response is a tuple containing four individual resultsets for accounts, folders, entries, and profiles. Pagination is across all four resultsets using the entity with the maximum number of results as the controller.

```
# search across all accounts
GET /search?query=:query-string&size:number&cursor=:string
# curl example
curl "https://localhost:4000/api/public/search?query=violin&size=10"
```

Search for matching Folders, Entries, and Profiles in Account

Searches for Folders, Entries, and Profiles that match query. This endpoint's response is a tuple containing three individual resultsets for folders, entries, and profiles. Pagination is across all resultsets using the entity with the maximum number of results as the controller.

```
# search all Folders and Entries in Account
GET /accounts/:account-id/search?query=:query-
```

```
# curl example

Account for matching Entries in Account - entries only

Searches only Entries that match query -- does not search for matching Folders

```
# search all Entries in Account (excludes Folders)
GET /accounts/:account-id/entries/search?query=:query-
string&size:number&cursor=:string

# curl example

query=brooch&size=10"

Search Folder in Account for matching Entries

```
# search within folder within account
GET /accounts/:account-id/folder/:folder-id/search?query=:query-
string&size:number&cursor=:string

Search Classification for matching Entries

Searches all Entries of specified classification—id for matches.
